A work plan is now being put into place to meet identified fire code compliance issues. **Event bookings are being permitted** when there is no conflict with work that needs to be done. A ULC fire rated Clear Coat Varnish product has been applied to a test section of paneling. There is no change to the natural look of the paneling and the product will be applied to the entire hall. Panel **repairs** and varnish application are scheduled between **November 21st and December 9th**. Building applications are being processed in order to do the required work to the walls and doorways in the basement. If there is any impact of this work on hall users, they will be notified and alternate arrangements will be offered.
