

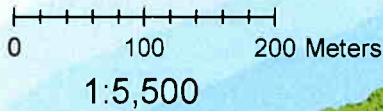


Gamiing

They are a vital part of the environment, housing a huge diversity of plant and animal life. They are vital in the landscape for their role as a "sponge", absorbing water during rainy seasons and releasing it slowly.
