

BALSAM LAKE PROVINCIAL PARK ROUTES

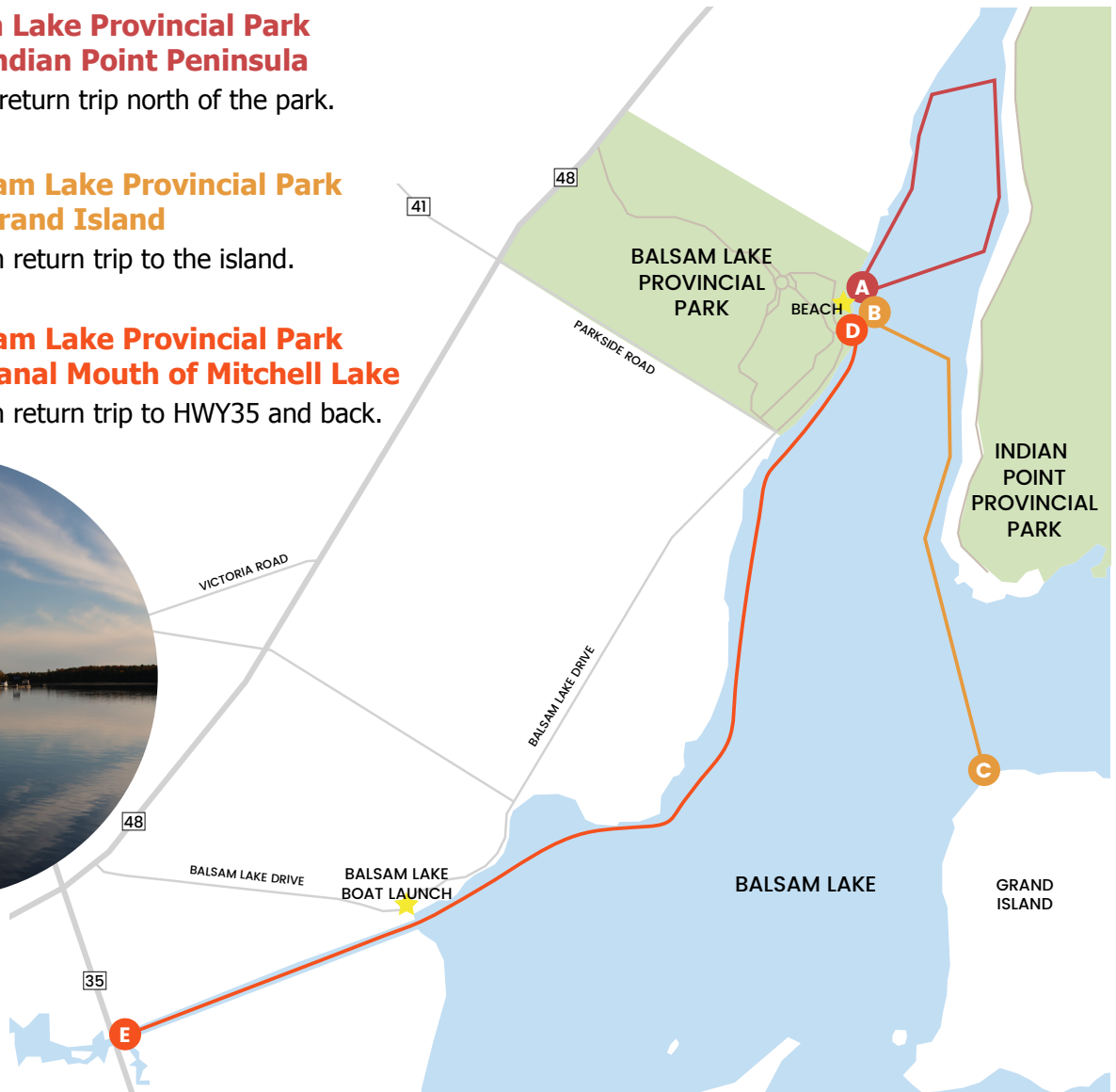
Difficulty: Moderate | **Route length:** 5km / 10km / 14+ km | **Portages:** None

Depending on the conditions and distance, this route can be characterized as easy to intermediate, with options of paddling to Indian Point Peninsula (5km return trip), Grand Island (10km return trip), or Canal Mouth (14km return trip). Canoes are available for rent from Balsam Lake Provincial Park, with a launch from the beautiful beachfront.

A | Balsam Lake Provincial Park beach to Indian Point Peninsula
Approx. 5km return trip north of the park.

B-C | Balsam Lake Provincial Park beach to Grand Island
Approx. 10km return trip to the island.

D-E | Balsam Lake Provincial Park beach to Canal Mouth of Mitchell Lake
Approx. 14km return trip to HWY35 and back.

- Combining your paddling adventure with an overnight camping trip at Balsam Lake Provincial Park
- Exploring the undeveloped eastern shore of Indian Provincial Park and Grand Island
- Challenging yourself with a longer route
- Trying a new route each day of your camping trip
