

# GULL RIVER

TO INDIAN POINT PP  
COBOCONK ROUTE

**Difficulty:** Easy | **Route length:** 8km | **Portages:** none

Spend three to four hours on this 8 km round-trip, beginning at the Coboconk Paddling Launch. Explore the undeveloped eastern shore of Indian Point Provincial Park, featuring alvar topography, a globally-rare ecosystem that supports a host of increasingly rare species, including many endangered birds.

## A-B | Coboconk to Indian Point Provincial Park

Approx 8km round-trip southbound on the Gull River, starting at the Coboconk Paddling Launch

- Combining your paddling adventure with an overnight camping trip at Balsam Lake Provincial Park
- Experiencing the same plain air painting and paddling locale of JEH MacDonald from the Group of Seven
- Exploring the undeveloped eastern shore of Indian Provincial Park, a non-operating park
