GULL RIVER TO INDIAN POINT PP COBOCONK ROUTE

Difficulty: Easy | Route length: 8km | Portages: none

Spend three to four hours on this 8 km round-trip, beginning at the Coboconk Paddling Launch. Explore the undeveloped eastern shore of Indian Point Provincial Park, featuring alvar topography, a globally-rate ecosystem that supports a host of increasingly rare species, including many endangered birds.



Ideal for:

- Combining your paddling adventure with an overnight camping trip at Balsam Lake Provincial Park
- Experiencing the same plein air painting and paddling locale of JEH MacDonald from the Group of Seven
- Exploring the undeveloped eastern shore of Indian Provincial Park, a non-operating park
