Total driving time: 52 minutes | Route length: 64 km

Discover the beauty of the fall colours reflecting on the peaceful water as you make your way through the heart of Kawartha Lakes. Drive along the lakesides of Sturgeon and Pigeon Lakes, stopping in bustling Bobcaygeon for a bite to eat or a walk around the shops. Make it a fun-filled family trip by visiting Kawartha Settlers' Village to experience what life was like for the pioneers in the Kawarthas. On your way back to Lindsay, take a moment in Verulam Park and beach, right on the edge of Sturgeon Lake to take pictures, stretch your legs, or enjoy an autumn lakeside picnic.

Finish your day with the Legends of Lore walking tour through historic downtown Lindsay or continue on the North West Route to experience the fall colours on Balsam and Cameron Lakes. The South East Route is filled with opportunities to experience the arts and culture of Kawartha Lakes with experiences for all ages to enjoy.

Bobcaygeon

A popular destination for those in search of recreation and relaxation, the downtown core of Bobcaygeon is actually located on an island.



Birthplace to the world renowned Kawartha Dairy Ice Cream and Bigley's Shoes and Clothing.



Deemed as "The Hub of the Kawarthas," Bobcaygeon is home to Lock 32, the first lock on the Trent-Severn Waterway.



Located at the meeting point of Pigeon and Sturgeon Lakes, providing visitors with many water activity options.



Top Stop:

Stop at the Verulam Park where the views of the lake are beautiful in the fall.

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SOUTH EAST ROUTE

C **START** in Cunningham's Corners, just off Hwy 7 outside of Lindsay and head east on **Traceys Hill Rd**

↩ Turn left onto **Centreline Rd/Kawartha Lakes County Rd 10**

↪ Turn right onto **Pigeon Lake Rd/Kawartha Lakes County Rd 17**

↪ Turn right onto **Kawartha Lakes County Rd 36** into Bobcaygeon

↩ Turn left onto **Boyd St** and continue onto **Canal St East**

↪ Turn right to stay on **Canal St E**

↩ Canal St E turns left and becomes **Sherwood St**

↪ Turn right onto **Park St/Kawartha Lakes County Rd 24**

★ Stop at **Verulam Park Beach** to take in the views of the fall colours over the lake

↪ Turn right onto **Kawartha Lakes County Rd 36** toward Lindsay

D **FINISH** in **Lindsay** at Colborne St East or head right on Colborne St East, which becomes Lindsay St North, turning right on Kent St West to explore the downtown
