

# NORTH WEST ROUTE

LINDSAY  
COBOCONK  
FENELON FALLS

Total driving time: 58 minutes | Route length: 69 km

Take the scenic route up around Balsam Lake from Lindsay to Fenelon Falls for the ultimate fall drive. With beautiful views of the waterways and lakes of the region, this route is one you don't want to miss. Get off the main highways to see the lush trees, rich with colours of the season as you make your way north from Lindsay towards Kirkfield. Take some time under the canopy of mature trees at the St. Thomas Cemetary to stretch your legs before you continue on the drive.

Pass by the Balsam Lake Dry Stone Wall as you make your way around Balsam Lake and stop for a hike or picnic at one of the area's Provincial Parks. Finish your trip with a walk through downtown Fenelon Falls or along the Garnet Graham Beach Park to get a view of the beautiful colours of the forests surrounding Cameron Lake.

## Fenelon Falls

Known as "The Jewel of the Kawarthas," Fenelon Falls is located in the centre of Kawartha Lakes, featuring a downtown core just steps away from the gorge connection.



Numerous offerings from local artisans, cafes, restaurants, and a craft brewery in the historic downtown.



Home to The Grove Theatre, a stunning outdoor amphitheatre presenting live performances for visitors to enjoy.



Located at the meeting point of Cameron and Sturgeon Lakes, the falls pour into a limestone gorge at Lock 34.

Stop at the St Thomas cemetary to indulge your senses with big trees and bigger colours.

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# S N O T I O N D IRECT

## NORTH WEST ROUTE

- E** **START** in Lindsay and head West on **Kent St W/ON-35 S**
- Turn right onto **Hwy 7/Trans-Canada Hwy/ON-7** (signs for Toronto)
- Turn right onto **Elm Tree Rd/ Kawartha Lakes County Rd 18**
- Turn left onto **Glenarm Rd/ Kawartha Lakes County Rd 8**
- Turn right onto **Fenel Rd/ Kawartha Lakes County Rd 35**
- Turn right onto **Portage Rd/ Kawartha Lakes County Rd 48**
- Turn right onto **Balsam Lake Dr**
- ★ Enjoy the mature colourful trees at **St Thomas Cemetery** on the corner of Portage Rd and Balsam Lake Dr
- ↑ Continue on **Balsam Lake Dr**
- Turn left onto **Parkside Rd**
- Turn right onto **Portage Rd/ Kawartha Lakes County Rd 48**
- Turn right onto **ON-35 S** (signs for Lindsay) and continue through Coboconk
- Turn left onto **Kawartha Lakes County Rd 43**
- Turn right onto **Northline Rd/ Kawartha Lakes County Rd 43**
- F** **FINISH** outside **Fenelon Falls** at the crossroads of Kawartha Lakes Country Rd 121 and Kawartha Lakes County Rd 8
- Turn right onto **Kawartha Lakes County Rd 121** toward downtown Fenelon Falls
