 - Head northwest on **ON-35 N** through Rosedale and Coboconk
- Turn right onto Monck Rd/
 Kawartha Lakes County Rd 45 toward
 Kinmount
- Stop at the **Kinmount Heritage Museum** to explore the park and heritage buildings
- Turn right onto Kawartha Lakes
 County Rd 121
- Turn right onto Concession Rd 11
- Turn left onto Pinery Rd
- Turn left onto Burnt River Rd
- Turn right onto Kawartha Lakes
 County Rd 121
- Take the first left onto **Ledge Hill Rd**
- Turn left onto Burys Green Rd/
 Kawartha Lakes County Rd 37
- Turn right onto Fairbairn Rd
- FINISH between Bobcaygeon and Fenelon Falls at Fairbairn Rd and Kawartha Lakes County Rd 8, turning left to head to Bobcaygeon or right to explore Fenelon Falls
