FEE'S LANDING EMILY PROVINCIAL PARK ROUTE

Difficulty: Easy | **Route length:** 4 km | **Portages:** None

This 4km round trip paddle will take you from the southeastern arm of Pigeon Lake into a river that winds to Emily Provincial Park. This makes for a nice opportunity to stop for a mid-way break or stay for the night, with full-service camping for tents and RVs, canoe racks, and a friendly tuck shop.



Ideal for:

- Pairing with a camping trip or going for a swim at Emily Provincial Park
- Experiencing nature, including the many unique frogs and birds that can be found in the wetland along the river
- Fishing for walleye, muskie, or large and small mouth bass
- Going further north to see the beauty of Pigeon Lake
